Kathy Lachman gave an update on the progress of the Area Agricultural Plan. Total of 79 action items; 28 are complete; 14 items are in progress, 31 items are yet to be addressed and 6 are duplicate items. Will be putting forward 2014 supplemental budget items in order to complete. Brochure has been developed entitled "So you want to move to the countryside...what you can expect". It is

Motion was carried to not proceed with farmstays. Land Owners do have option to go through public re-zoning process. Resolution was communicated to delegate, Rick Pipes, via Planning and Development and Geoff Millar.

Re: Movie Theatre

The CVRD Economic Development Commission has received the letter from the City of Duncan, dated May 27, 2013 asking us to respond to the Junior Council motion that a new location for a movie theatre is examined, and that various movie theatre companies be contacted and asked whether they would consider locating to the City of Duncan. The matter was discussed at the July 18, 2013 meeting of the CVRD Economic Development Commission. (The Commission did not meet in formal session in the month of June).

The outcome of the discussion is that Economic Development Manager, Geoff Millar, will meet with the management of Caprice Theatre and connect with several chain movie theatre companies and ask for responses to the Junior Council motion. Two of the primary objectives within Economic Development are Business Retention and Expansion and Business/Investment Attraction, and this project certainly falls within these areas.

Our plan is to gather the answers to your questions and we will respond to Junior Council at that time. We hope to see this completed within 60 days. Thank you for your deliberation on this topic and your interest in the on-going economic wellbeing of downtown Duncan.

I had been asked by the chairman of the EDC to form a subcommittee of members to look at and make recommendations coming out of the Rettich Report. The members of the Subcommittee were Sandra Goth, Russ Jenkins, Dana Thorne, Roger Hart, Marsha Stanley and myself. There was to be a meeting on August 20 with a cast much larger than the members of the subcommittee to discuss the Rettich Report. The members of the subcommittee decided to meet separately on August 8th so we could get our thoughts clear without outside influence. That meeting did take place with all members of the subcommittee except Marsha as she had a prior commitment. The following came out of that meeting.

The Subcommittee is concerned with the ineffectiveness of the Economic Development Commission in its present state and this was reflected in Rettichs report. There appears to be no sense of accomplishment within the group and a sense that we have no control over agenda. Our meetings have little purpose. To address the issues put forward in the report the following was suggested:

- The EDC Chair and Vice Chair will define the agenda;
- Delegations are accepted to a max of 2 per meeting and adhere to a strict time limit of 10 minutes as per CVRD Delegation By-Law;
- Written follow up from delegations to be prepared by staff go out from the Commission
- Time is allowed on each agenda for follow up of all active files i.e. farm stay, theatre initiative;
- If required, To Do lists be created for the staff and next steps be listed in the minutes;
- Circulate delegation submissions to Commission members two weeks ahead of time;
- Time is allowed for reports from ED Commission members appointed to or employed by the Environment Commission, the Regional Agricultural Advisory Commission, Vancouver Island University and Cowichan Tribes;
- Time is allowed on each agenda for big picture thinking;
- A Vice Chair be appointed by the CVRD Board Chair;
- For clarity, refer to operational staff as EDC and the Commission as the Economic Development Commission.

The responsibilities of the Commission outlined by the CVRD in the EDC Establishment By-Law include the following – "Support and promote economic development efforts within the Cowichan Valley Regional District." As the other responsibilities to develop and implement a community economic development strategy require funding and the Commission does not have a budget, our concentration will be on the first responsibility. All of the suggestions in this report support this responsibility.
