Application DP18E06 4979 Polkey Road

Presentation by Cam Williams, representing Super Save Enterprises

Mr. Williams presented a Development Permit application to remove vegetation, import gravel and establish a parking area for the owner's commercial/industrial vehicle fleet.

- 1) Main points and history of the parcel and the application
- 2) Landscaping and screening:
 - owner concerned with visibility of the property
 - currently has barbed wire fencing
 - no desire/plan currently to build on site
 - Madrone Environmental Services Report regarding RAR regulations
 - if further development planned will submit a new application
 - supplemental storage for Victoria location

APC Discussion

- concern that a landscape plan was not submitted with application
- commended applicant for oil water separators and water drainage plans, asked about maintenance plan for oil water separators
- acknowledged applicant for addressing Busy Place Creek and the aquifer beneath, would like to see landscape plan submitted to the CVRD and/or working with the CVRD to create one
- concern related to heat island effect, would like to see landscaping and plantings that may be able to survive after two years of care, watering. Reference to high water table
- focus on habitat appropriate to Busy Place Creek
- queried source and type of fill to be brought on site emphasizing ecologically sensitive nature of KIP
- would encourage applicants to participate in future planning opportunities for the Koksilah Business Park
- APC to forward reference material for petro barriers researched by stream keepers working in the area

Applicant address of APC Discussion points

- landscape plan: had decided to wait until after meeting with APC before submitting a landscaping plan. Cited no available water on site
- presented a photo of landscaping in front of C&C Lath as an example
- oil water separators: best management plan, serviced annually
- has ideas of possible bioswales and having driving aisles
- granular structural material for the permeable surface sourced from Butler's Gravel Pit

Recommendation: That the application be approved provided the recommendations below are realized.

- 1) Submission of a landscaping plan that is fish friendly and is predominately native and drought tolerant species with irrigation plans that will support the long-term viability of the plantings. That a parking plan be integrated into the landscape plan.
- 2) That the landscaping and screening will adhere to the DPA guidelines

- 3) That the applicant submits figures for the total site imperviousness and the installation of oil water separators and *seepage pits as described in the application. That a schedule of maintenance is followed.
- 4) That the gravel/fill material be sourced from a reputable company.

The Advisory Planning Commission encourages the CVRD to adopt a local area plan for the area known as the Koksilah Industrial Park and rename it to the Koksilah Business Park.
