NEW BUSINESS NB1 Kerry Park Redevelopment Project

Richard Furbacher presented the LTA Consultants Inc report which included detailed cost information for the redevelopment project as well as conceptual drawings that the report was based on; costs are based on the assumption that top quality materials will be used in construction; review of items not included in the costing were noted and are include in the report with the exception of the exterior east facing wall which we may want to resurface to update the look to match the new construction; confirmation was given that the costing included a deeper pool to accommodate a regular size diving board; suggestion was made to look at updating the existing bleachers so it has a new look and feel when entering the existing arena are; Richard will look into the following costscost to include the library into the new facility, cost to include new plastic bench bleachers to update the current system;

MOTION That staff move forward with preparing a recommendation to the CVRD Board, That staff be authorized to prepare a Loan Authorization Bylaw for up to \$27 million to renovate the Kerry Park Recreation Centre to include an Aquatic Centre and the possibility of a Library space.

NEW BUSINESS NB2 Olympic Torch Relay

Activities are now being planned for both communities and the Provincial Government has announced a grant for up to \$8,000 per community to assist the preparation of this event for the route communities.
