CVRD offices and recycling centres closed for National Day of Mourning on Monday, September 19

Duncan, BC – In recognition of the National Day of Mourning announced by the Government of Canada, the Cowichan Valley Regional District (CVRD) will close its administrative offices and recycling centres on Monday, September 19 in honour of the passing of Queen Elizabeth II.

The CVRD head office at 175 Ingram St. will be closed, as will the Meade Creak, Peerless Road and Bings Creek Recycling Centres. Other CVRD facilities, including the Cowichan Community Centre, Cowichan Performing Arts Centre, Kerry Park Recreation Centre, Shawnigan Lake Community Centre and Cowichan Lake Sports Arena, will remain open for regularly scheduled programming. However, office hours for administrative staff at these facilities that provide assistance with general inquires, registrations and bus pass purchases may be reduced.
