R1 West Cowichan Facility Coordinators Verbal Report Re: Update on the Chiller

> The bid for the chiller grant did not go through. We will be going ahead with the project and will be hiring a consultant come January 2017.

R3 Director I. Morrison Verbal Report

At the December 14, 2016 Board Meeting, the Board elected Jon Lefebure, North Cowichan Director, as Board Chair and Bob Day, Lake Cowichan Director, as Vice-Chair for a period ending November 2017.

In the 2017 Budget Area I is at 3.68%, Area F is 3.97% and the Town of Lake Cowichan is 3.17%, so we hold 3 of the 4 lowest positions in the CVRD for the lowest increases.

R4 Mayor R. Forrest, Verbal Report Re: Town of Lake Cowichan Update

2016 has been a good year for investments in the Town of Lake Cowichan such as the expansion of South Shore Cabinetry.

Work on Centennial Park is underway and Dawn Coe Jones will have a field named after her upon completion of the project.

The 6 million dollar capital project for water treatment should be completed in 2017 as should the 1.3 million dollar upgrades to water mains.

There will be a 2.75% increase to Town taxes.

The Town Hall tender should go out in January of 2017.
