D1 Lorraine Gagnon, President Kerry Park Curling Centre

REPORTS

R1 Managers Report

K. Liddle, Manager, South Cowichan Recreation, produced a verbal report and monthly update for information.

Our annual Canada Day celebration held at Elsie Miles Park was a success with many members of the Cowichan Valley coming out to celebrate. We also hosted a Canada Day dance in the curling rink. The event was put on in partnership with the Mill Bay Community League and saw 210 patrons in attendance.

There are a few changes to the budget process for this year. Staff will bring present the core and supplemental items to the Commission in October.

Staff continue to work with the software company to work through the difficulties being experienced.

The fall Activity guide will be out mid-August with registration starting the following week.

R2 Facility Coordinators Report

T. Liddle, Facility Coordinator, South Cowichan Recreation, produced a verbal report and monthly update for information.

The replacement of the domestic hotwater tank is almost complete. The project is under budget and within our anticipated timeline.

Replacement Chiller project is under budget and expected to be completed within our anticipated timeframe. The chillers are plate and frame technology which is expected to reduce the amount of ammonia in the system by approximately 25%.

Staff continue to work on the skate park and outdoor fitness equipment projects. A riparian report was completed and our project meets all requirements with the note to be careful around the stream.

Ice installation will start shortly in order to be completed for the beginning of August.
