All applicants that apply for a licence must complete a 45-day public consultation period as part of the licence application process; see the 'Notification and Public Consultation' section of the *Licence Application Guide* and Schedule 'D' of Bylaw No. 2570. A template is available on the CVRD's website. The CVRD requires that the notice be posted on three separate occasions in a

local newspaper that is distributed at least weekly in the area where the facility is located. The public consolation period will be considered to have started at the time of the initial newspaper publication. All notices at the facility location must also be posted at this time and should be maintained during the 45-day period.
