



Day Three: May 3, 2020

PAINTING ROCKS

This activity gets people moving out in nature (safely), using creativity and brings community together – even when we have to be apart!

Step 1: Head out into nature, keeping as safe distance from others, and collect some rocks with flat surfaces.

Step 2: Clean off any dirt that may be on rock.

Step 3: Paint rock or write a positive message.

Step 4: Let the paint dry – if you are worried about paint chipping off, there are a number of sealants that can be used to protect the paint.

Step 5: Once the painted rock is complete, hide the rock somewhere in the community for others to find and enjoy.



Supplies needed:

- Rock
- Paint
- Paint brushes
- Permanent Marker
